## A Message from Tom

November 2020

Welcome to November! It is a month to remember! Every year on November 11th, Canadians pause in a silent moment of remembrance for the men and women who have served and continue to serve our country during times of war, conflict and peace.

On Remembrance Day members of the armed forces (soldiers, sailors and airmen) are commemorated. This marks the date and time when armies stopped fighting World War I. on November 11th at 11:00am in 1918 (the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month).

One of history's most famous wartime poems, "In Flanders Fields" was written during the First World War by Canadian officer and surgeon John McCrae. It helped popularize the red poppy as a symbol of Remembrance. McCrae jotted down this most famous of war poem in 20 minutes during the Battle of Ypres.

*In Flanders fields the poppies blow  
Between the crosses, row on row,  
That mark our place: and in the sky  
The larks still bravely singing fly  
Scarce heard amid the guns below.*
