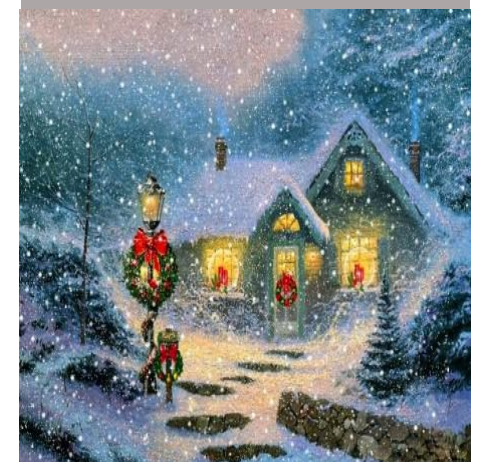
Hello December

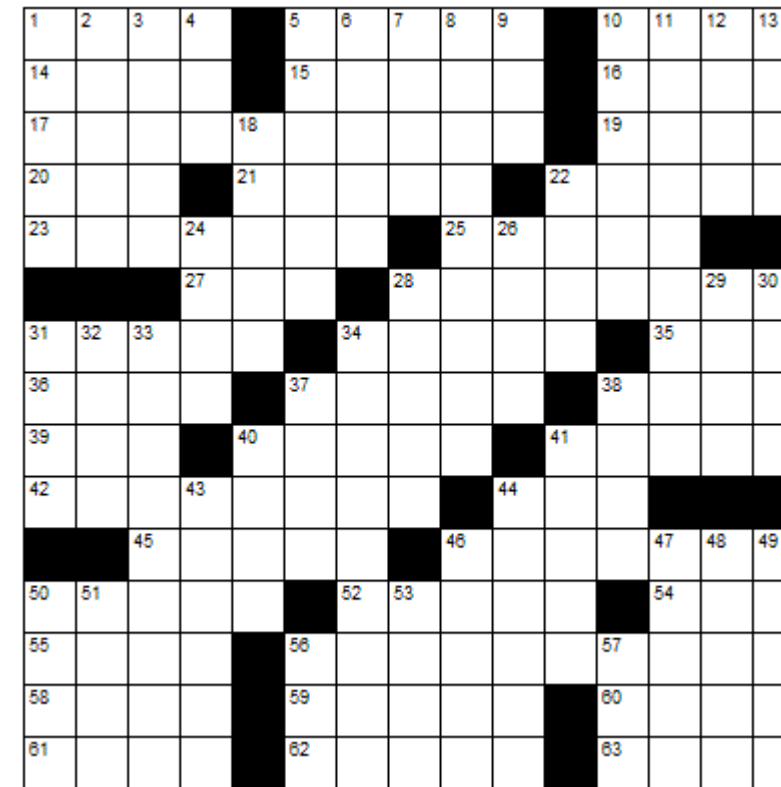
Queens Avenue Christmas Market:
